Guidelines for Application for a Grant-in-Aid

Plymouth Marine Science and Education Foundation (PlyMSEF) provides travel grants to enable research students to attend academic conferences and symposia or to attend advanced training courses or workshops in marine disciplines. For 2017 up to eight awards, to the value of £400 will be available in a competition process for applicants who meet the criteria as follows:

- i) Applicants must be registered PhD students or postgraduate scientists (excluding MRes students) within 4 years of graduation employed in marine –related research projects at one of the following institutions”
 - DDRC Healthcare
 - Marine Biological Association of the United Kingdom
 - National Marine Aquarium
 - Plymouth Marine Laboratory
 - Plymouth University Marine Institute
 - Sir Alister Hardy Foundation for Ocean Science
- ii) Applications must be supported in writing by the applicant’s supervisor;
- iii) The conference, symposia *etc* for which the grant is requested must take place after Monday 27 February 2017.
- iv) Applications from those who have already presented at the annual student conference will be viewed favourably.

Successful applicants must produce short reports within two weeks of the events and be prepared to give an oral presentation at the annual student conference
